Soaring Eagles Academy

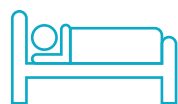
Each of the following items are offered to 100% of our program participants during the first 30 days of their stay. Depending on their length of stay, they may or may not actually receive them.

All of our program participants have received the following:



HYGIENE PACKS

Thanks to community partners each man receives a hygiene package upon entry. This includes, soap, shaving cream, razors, shampoo, conditioner, deodorant, toothpaste, and toothbrush.



BED AND BEDDING

Each man gets their own comfortable bed complete with fresh linens and a brand-new pillow.



INITIAL PAROLE VISIT

Each man is transported to check in with his parole officer within the first 24 hours of his arrival at Eagles Nest Ministries - Soaring Eagles Academy. We provide transportation throughout his stay until he can purchase his own vehicle.



Still within the first 30 days:



98%

of our men have been given a voucher for clothing through the Assistance League - we set the appointment and transport them to get essential clothing items

96%

of our men have been given a voucher for clothing through Angelic Resale, a Creative Outreach Ministry. Again, we set the appointment for them and transport.

\$50

For the other essential clothing items, namely undergarments, our men are taken to Walmart and allowed to spend \$50.00 covered by the ministry for those items.



95%

have received transportation to the DPS (Department of Public Safety) office: Once fines have been taken care of, a man is able to procure his driver's license. We transport him for both written and driving tests if needed to get his license either reinstated or renewed.

96%

have received transportation to Texas Health and Human Services to apply for food stamps: Men are transported to apply for food stamps. Though we receive donations for communal meals, men still need to be able to purchase food items for themselves.

91%

have received transportation to the district clerk's office: Each man is transported to the District Clerks office to obtain a list of all fines and fees that he owes. We then assist him in filling out indigent status paperwork for the court in the hope that his fines will be forgiven or significantly reduced.





75%

have received health care: Through our working relationship with Montgomery County Hospital District, a representative comes here to assist our men in applying for the Health Care Assistance Program.

81%

(as needed basis) seen by a medical dr.: For those in need medical care, they are transported to generalists as well as specialists. Prior to HCAP being established, if there is an emergent need, men are taken to a local urgent care.

43%

(as needed basis) have been seen by an optometrist: Many times, our men do not even realize they needed glasses. We transport them to an eye dr. for examination and if required the acquisition of glasses/contact lenses.

17%

(as needed basis) receive dental care: Dental health has many times been neglected, some to the point of needing many or all teeth removed. One man in our program has undergone a complete extraction and received a new set of dentures.

Fatherhood Effect Program: is a parenting education course that uses the 24/7 Dad curriculum, which teaches the characteristics of a good father, like masculinity, discipline, and work-family balance. Our men learn how to:

- Improve your children's behavior problems
- Deal with complicated emotions
- Overcome issues of aggression, alcohol, and violence
